Application - Alberta Dental Association and College

Requirements

- Copy of National Dental Examining Board of Canada - Certificate
- Official transcripts from each post-secondary institution related to dental education (sent directly from educational institution)
- Certified or notarized copies of degrees/diplomas earned
- Three(3) character references (signed, dated and submitted with application)
- Letter of Good Standing and/or Certificate of Good Standing (directly from regulatory body)
- Completed - Consent(s) for Release of Information
- Passport-sized photograph (2" high x 1 1/2" wide)
- Proof of continuing education (if currently in practice and have been in practice for two (2) years or more)
- Completed - Application for Registration as General Dentist
